In order to attend and maintain membership in the Lincoln High School Computer Club, students must sign and agree to abide by the following expectations. Not meeting an expectation will result in being asked to leave a club meeting or a phone call/e-mail home. If the expectations are repeatedly not met, the student will no longer be allowed to attend club meetings and will no longer be considered a member.

Lincoln High School Computer Club members are expected to:

- choose a computer-related project to work on. Projects must be approved by Miss Gurganus. (Common examples are HTML website design, animation, and game design.)
- actively work on the chosen project from 2:50 - 3:30 pm during any club meetings attended
- not play games (at all—unless they are Club-created) or browse the Internet (unless project-related) until 3:30 pm during club meetings attended
- not download any program onto the school computers without permission from Miss Gurganus
- follow the LHS Computer Club AUP (see back of this form)
- not engage in horseplay
- only use school-appropriate language (both verbally and on computer-related projects)

Refreshments will only be for club members working on projects. Only those working for 30 or more minutes will be allowed to have club refreshments.

By signing this expectations sheet, I agree to follow all of the above expectations. I also understand that if I do not follow them, I will be asked to leave the club meeting and/or lose the privilege of attending Computer Club meetings.
